VEO CAMERA IN ACTION

The club has recently purchased a Veo 2 camera. With Veo's powerful Al technology, it automatically produces game highlights showing kick-off, half-time, full-time, and all of the game's key events, including goals. Veo is not only a camera; it is also an analysis tool.

Our U13, U14 & U15 teams have been fortunate enough to benefit from use of the Veo 2. Footage is shared with players, who are able to review their performance. Head coach Mike is looking to develop further analysis, linking in with the development of our club characteristics and playing approach.
